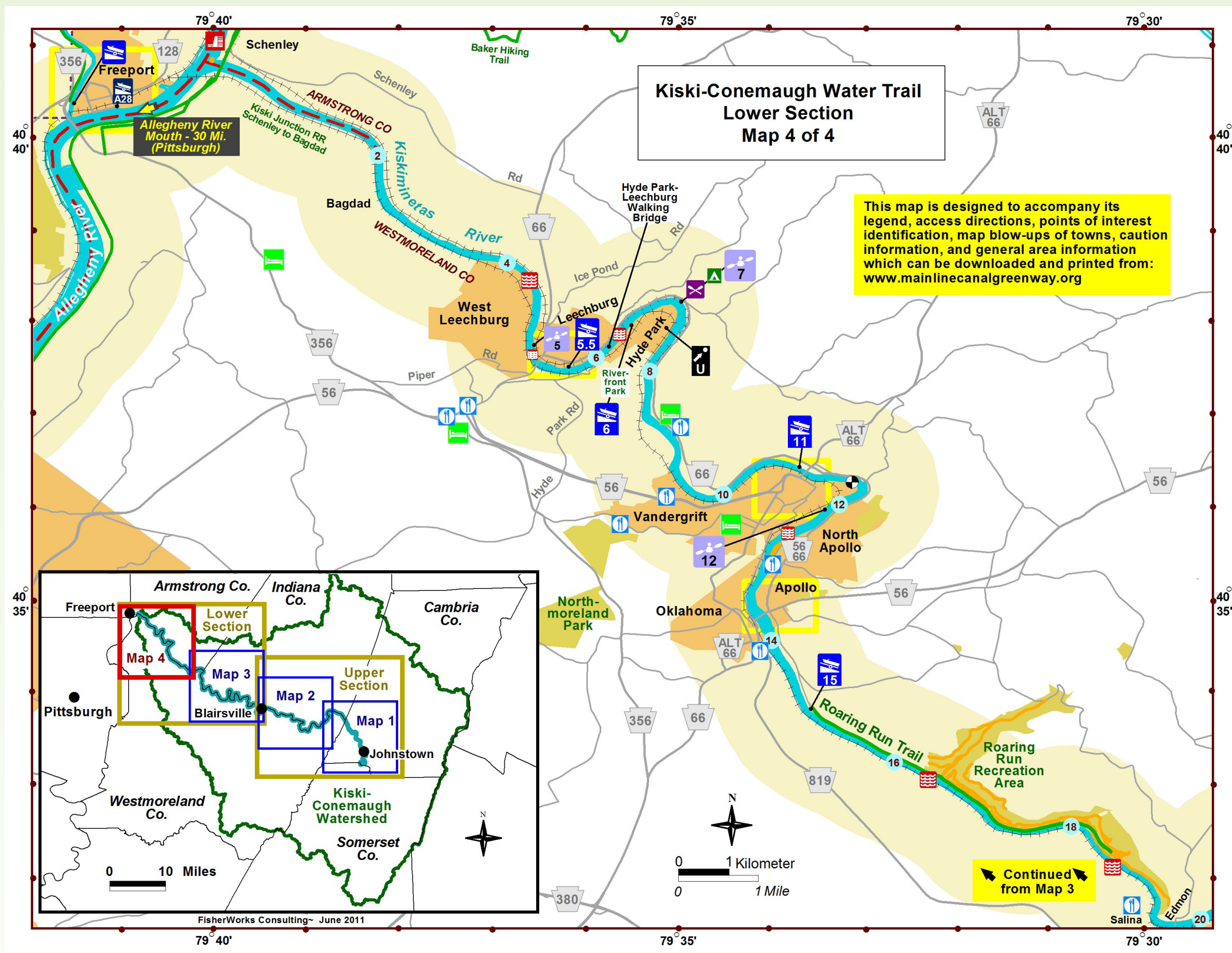

Avonmore history dates back to before the Revolutionary War. The area's first permanent European resident, Stephen Rinebolt, settled here around 1732, eventually drawing more families from his native Holland to this "plain by the river."
