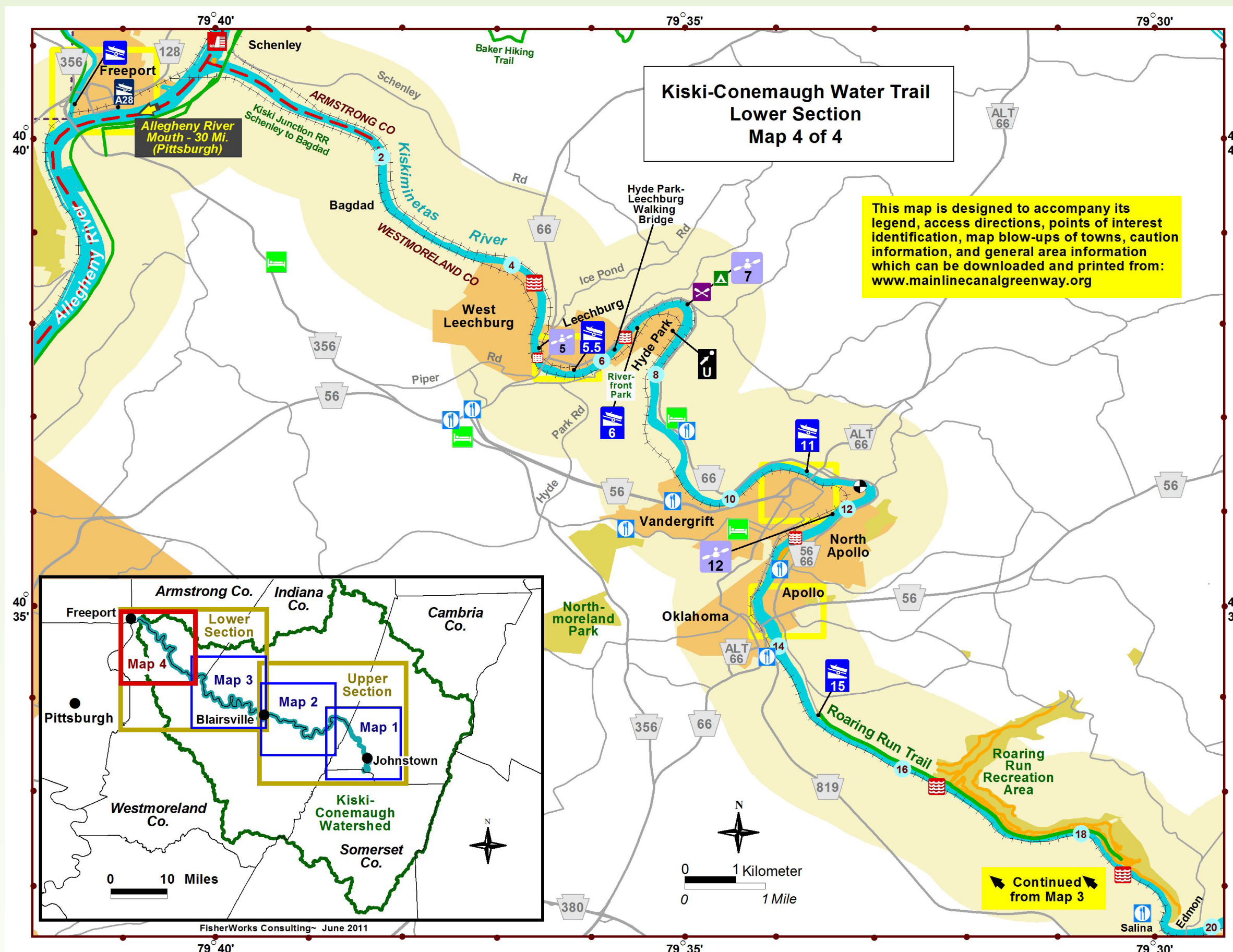


PITTSBURGH-TO-HARRISBURG MAIN LINE CANAL GREENWAY™

Johnstown's surrounded by 323 miles of biking on 17 rail-trails; hundreds of miles of flat-water canoeing and kayaking; 15 Class III waterways for 73 miles of whitewater paddling; 250 miles of hiking on 48 trails; 41 mountain biking trails; 1,800 miles of trout fishing; four ski resorts plus 99 miles of Nordic skiing; 14 state parks; and four national parks! Outdoor recreation enthusiasts are drawn to Johnstown not only to visit, but to live and work and enjoy affordable living, rich cultural depth, friendly people, and a sense of community.
